Die EP LONE TREE entstand im Sommer 2016 in relativ kurzer Zeit nach dem Album DELIGHTED und geht direkt auf die Wurzeln des Songwritings des Autors und Sängers zurück. „Song in Your Eyes“ wurde vor ziemlich genau dreißig Jahren geschrieben (!), die anderen 4 Songs zum Zeitpunkt der Produktion. Zu erwähnen wäre noch die Nummer 5 „Of a World That's Weary“ in welcher Markus seine Sicht hinsichtlich der Flüchtlingssituation zum

Ausdruck bringt. Ein Titel der ein möglicher Kandidat für eine neue australische Fernsehserie ist. Deswegen hat er seit der Produktion auch den Arbeitstitel „Frank's Theme“

LONE TREE is an EP which was produced in very short time after finishing the album DELIGHTED in summer 2016. It's the kind of songwriting Markus Zosel started with way back thirty years ago, and, in fact, there's one song that had been written right in

those days: it's "Song in Your Eyes". But all the other four song are from the days of the production. You might take care of the fifth song of the EP: That's "Of a World That's Weary". Markus reflects there on his feeling about the refugee problem of Europe with a lot of people coming and a horrible situation they are in.

This song is also 'in waiting' for its use in an Australian TV production. So. Let's see what happens to it in the times to come.
